1.	Visa application form correctly filled out in English and signed by the applicant or by his/her legal guardian		
2.	OFII form (only for not dependent ascendant)		
3.	Two recent passport-size photographs with a white background, not stapled. Full face ; no face cover that prevent full visibility of facial features		
4.	Original passport : - valid for at least three months after the end of the stay or of the expiration date of the visa - containing at least two adjacent blank pages and issued within the previous 10 years		
5.	One copy of the passport front page and all relevant pages containing previous Schengen, UK, US, Canada visas with immigration stamps (within the last 5 years only) Copy of Iqama and the certificate of final exit (in case the visa is granted)		
6.	Proof of family relationship between the visa applicant and the descendant: full copy of the birth certificate of the descendant <u>If the descendant is not a French national:</u> transcription's copy of the marriage certificate of the foreign descendant with a French national, made in the French consular civil status registers issued within the last two months		
7.	Proof of French nationality of the descendant: French ID card copy		
8.	Proof of the resources of the ascendant in the country of residence: pension, payslips, property income, any other proof of incomes.		
9.	Proof that the ascendant is dependent upon the descendant : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recent and regular bank transfers from the descendant to the ascendant over a significant period of time • Proof of the descendant's income and his/her tax income notice • Information about the family composition of the descendant 		
10.	Information about the housing conditions of the ascendant during his/her stay in France Copy of the host's lease contract or property tax notice		
11.	If the ascendant is under 65: commitment not to be engaged in any occupation in France		
12.	For non-Saudi, final exit may be requested before visa issuance.		
13.	Medical insurance subscribed in France, covering the first 3 months of stay (for all expenses other than emergency) Note that is it different from a Schengen insurance.		
14.	All documents in Arabic should be translated in English by a certified translator		
15.	Comment: The applicant insists to submit his/her file even if the visa application is not complete		
16.	Declaration - I have been informed that : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • My passport will be under custody of the Embassy of France in Riyadh during the process of my Schengen visa application which can take up to 15 days • An application without the complete set of documents according to the above mentioned checklist may result in a rejection of my visa application • The Embassy of France reserves the right to ask for additional supporting documents if necessary and does not guarantee the issue of the Visa. In case of a refusal, visa fees are not refundable
