Documentation that you have a return ticket or sufficient funds to buy a return ticket (an amount equivalent to DKK 5,000).

\* Please note that, as a rule, SIRI will refuse your application for a residence permit on new grounds, if the application is submitted prematurely in relation to the wished for start date for your stay
