It must include details of the inviting person (name, address and contact information, date of birth) and the following information of the invited person: name, date of birth, address and contact information, purpose and length of visit, mentioning if the guest is a relative, friend etc. Invitation letters <b>do not need</b> to be notarized in Finland.</li> </ul>

The following documents shall be presented by either of the categories: a) if the applicant is employed: - letter from employer and/or approval for leave - SGK (social security) registration document plus SGK "hizmet dökümü" b) if the applicant is a farmer: - farmer certificate issued by chamber of agriculture c) if the applicant is employed by or owner of a private company: - company registration in chamber of commerce and copy of the bulletin of the trade register - statement of taxes payment d) if the applicant is retired: - proof of pension (either bank account statement of pensioner booklet) e) if the applicant is a student: - student certificate (Ögrenci Belgesi) f) it the applicant is a minor or under age 18 and travelling alone or with one parent or legal guardian only: - public notary approved statement from his/her parents
8.	Travel medical insurance, original or copy of the certificate. The insurance must have minimum coverage of 30.000 euro and cover costs of any emergency medical treatment and repatriation for medical reasons as well as in case of death repatriation of the deceased.
