 - A Photo service complying to the Indian norms are available in our offices
- 4 Copy of Dutch passport
- 5 Copies of Indian passport (first and last page) In case passport dates back to 80s or 90s ☐
 - In case the passport dates back to the 80s and 90s a copy of the first 4 pages is required
- 6 Copy of Naturalization certificate (Bekendmaking) or Uittreksel specifying the date when the applicant became a Dutch citizen ☐
- 7 Copies of supporting documents as proof of having held an Indian nationality such as marriage certificate, birth certificate, school certificates etc. ☐
 - At least two of the above documents must be provided (originals need to be shown to the officer at the counter)
- 8 Affidavit for change in name (if applicable) ☐
- 9 Declaration form : to be filled by all applicants submitting any application ☐
