- 1 **Original passport valid for a minimum of 6 months (or for the validity requested, if greater) and having at least 2 blank visa pages, and a copy** ☐
- 2 **Two photographs conforming to Indian Government norms as per specifications mentioned on our website** ☐
 - A Photo service complying to the Indian norms is available in our offices
- 3 **An Indian Government Regular Visa application form duly filled in online and signed on pages 1 and 2** ☐

- 4 **A letter from the Indian company, with a proper letter head and stamp, addressed to the Embassy of India in Madrid, specifying the exact purpose of your visit and the expected start and end dates of the first mission as well as the next missions if already planned. This letter should be on company letterhead and written in English with a stamp and signature.** ☐
- 5 **A letter from your employer, with a proper letter head and stamp, addressed to the Embassy of India in Madrid, specifying the exact purpose of the applicant's visit and the expected start and end dates. This letter should be on company letterhead and written in English with a stamp and signature.** ☐
- 6 **Declaration form : to be filled by all applicants submitting any application** ☐
- 7 **Additional documents mentioned below as per your case** ☐

LIST OF ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS

If the applicant is not holding a Spanish passport

- Registration Certificate from the concern City Council/Municipal (minimum period of stay in Spain is 2 years), with an issue date which should not exceed 180 days. ☐
- Referral form duly filled in Capital Letters ☐

If the applicant obtained Spanish nationality by naturalization and previously held Bangladeshi, Pakistani or Sri Lankan nationality

- Literal Birth certificate. (Certificación literal de nacimiento) ☐
- Nationality certificate proving when Spanish nationality was obtained ☐

If the applicant is a freelancer

- A letter in which the applicant states that he/she is a freelancer and does not have stamp and letterhead ☐

If the applicant is going for an internship through AIESEC in a private limited/profit company

- A formal letter from the Indian company, with the letterhead of it containing details of the offer, type of work to be done and to receive salary and workplace in India and the term of the Internship ☐
- One of the following documents: ☐
 - Certificate from college to Internship in India
 - Certificate of the Spanish company which sends the applicant to India Internship specifying the relationship with the Indian company and who will be responsible for payment, expenses and stay in India.
 - AIESEC certificate or Faro for Global Internship.
