1	Application Form duly filled in and signed by the applicant.		
2	Two recent passport size photographs in colour with white background (3.5cm by 4.5cm). Please do not staple the photographs to the application form.		
3	Passport/Travel document must:		
	a) Have a validity of at least 3 months after the intended stay;		
	b) Have been issued within the previous 10 years and the validity must not exceed 10 years; and		
	c) Have 2 blank pages.		
4	Photocopy of all pages of current and previous passport		
5	Adhaar card (along with a photocopy)		
5	Proof of social or professional status including letter detailing purpose of trip and information about the research that will be carried out in Malta.		
6	Letter from employer or educational institute in India justifying the applicant's need to travel to Malta for research purposes.		
7	Invitation from a firm/authority in Malta giving details about the nature of the research. Proof		
8	of sufficient funds to cover all expenses during the stay in Malta, including copy of Bank letter, Original Bank statement for the six months, tax return for last three years and salary slips of last three months.		
9	Proof of Accommodation.		
10	Travel Itinerary with travel dates, including a return flight reservation or ticket.		
11	Overseas travel medical insurance valid for all Schengen countries. The insurance has to cover the applicant for at least 30,000 Euros or equivalent, for all risks e.g. accident, illness, medical emergency, evacuation etc. The policy has to clearly specify the period of validity and has to cover the entire duration of the trip including the date of arrival and departure.		

NOTE: The High Commission reserves the right to request further documentation. Original Documents must be presented during the personal interview with the visa officer
