

# Embassy of Denmark in Mexico

Dear Applicant

Your application and documentation will be delivered to the Embassy of Denmark and your case will be processed by the Embassy as soon as possible and normally within 15 calendar days from date of submission at the Visa Application Centre (VAC).

Please note that your application is **incomplete**. The documents marked below are missing. The Embassy kindly requests that you hand in the following documentation to the VAC **within 5 working days** from the submission date:



## Document checklist for visa for culture / sports visit:

Missing document(s)	Type of document
	<b>1. Visa Application Form.</b> Duly completed form with signature and date. <b>ORVSS cover letter</b> with signature and date.
	<b>2. Proof of fee payment of full fee IF paid online at VSS website.</b>
	<b>3. One passport photo.</b> The photograph must be passport-size(35x45 mm) with a solid, light colour background, no older than 6 months.
	<b>4. Passport,</b> valid at least 90 days beyond your intended departure date from the Schengen Area. <b>Passport</b> must have at least 2 blank pages for visas.
	<b>5. Copy (in colour) of all pages in your passport – incl. identity pages</b>
	<b>6. Travel medical insurance</b> with a minimum coverage of EUR 30,000 valid for the duration of your stay in the Schengen area.
	<b>7. Original and copy of a valid visa and/or residence permit to Mexico or third country in which you reside.</b> Residence permit must be valid for at least 3 months after your intended departure date from the Schengen Area.
	<b>8. Confirmed flight/travel booking</b> (not yet issued ticket), or e-ticket.
	<b>11. Invitation letter from host:</b> Use invitation form 'VU2' duly completed, dated and signed by host.
	<b>9. Hotel booking or confirmation of other accommodation.</b> If staying with host this must be stated in invitation letter (or VU2 form).
	<b>10. Proof of financial means to support yourself during your stay in the Schengen Area.</b> Upon entry into Denmark, a visa holder must usually prove to be in possession of approx. DKK 500 per day if staying at hotel, DKK 350 per day if staying in a hostel or similar or a lesser amount if accommodation is pre- paid, or if the accommodation is private, and the host has accepted to be responsible for all expenses.
	<b>11. For employees:</b> letter from employer on company paper with stamp, date and signature, company address, telephone no. and contact person(s); name and position of the countersigning officer; traveller's name, job position, salary and years of service; approval of leave/absence. <b>For unemployed persons:</b> Documentation of spouse or partner's employment and salary or other type of own regular income. <b>For retired persons:</b> Proof of pension or other regular income. <b>For students:</b> Valid student card; letter from school confirming current enrolment.
	<b>11. For minors:</b> Original documentation (and one copy) of family relation or proof of guardianship – must have Apostille – and one copy thereof. Minors travelling alone or with just one parent: Original document (and one copy) of permission to travel from both parents or legal guardians <b>or</b> the parent or legal guardian not travelling. Document must have Apostille.

The Embassy of Denmark requests you to hand in the required documentation no later than     [date = 5 working days counting from the day after submission]    .

If the missing documentation has not been submitted by the abovementioned deadline, the Embassy of Denmark shall process your application and make a decision based on the existing information and documents in the case.

Please choose one of the following options:

When submitting additional documentation or making enquiries to the VAC, kindly remember to always state your passport number and case number ID (the latter to be found on the receipt from the VAC).
