	The Original passport should be valid for at least 3 months beyond the intended duration of stay in the Schengen territory and with at least two blank page to affix the visa. The passport must have been issued within the last 10 years.			
	Copy of previous visas and stamps of the applicant's old passport(s) <i>if any</i> .			
	Copy of name or surname change certificate, if applicable.			
	Proof of integration : into the country of residence: Household registration record.			
	Documents from host: □Invitation letter signed by the spouse/cohabitant confirming current living situation, purpose of travel, itinerary, accommodation in Denmark/Iceland/Faroe Islands/Greenland and their intention to return to Vietnam. □ Copy of spouse/cohabitant's passport, showing either a valid residence/work permit or visa to Vietnam.			
	Proof of relationship. Copy of marriage certificate or proof of cohabitation for at least a year.			
	Proof of occupation. - If the applicant is employed: 1) the last three payslips, 2) labour contract or original documents confirming employment at recent date, 3) approval for holidays are required. - If the applicant is a company owner or self-employed: certificate of registrations of the company* and statement of taxes payment are required. - If the applicant is retired: Pension statement is required			
	Documentation of funds to cover the trip. According to the Danish Immigration Service you must have the necessary means to pay for your stay and return trip. As a general rule, you must have at your disposal approx. DKK 350 per day. A smaller amount may be accepted if you are staying in a private home and your host will cover all costs. If you are staying at a hotel, the amount must be greater, approx. DKK 500 per day. You can find further information https://www.nyidanmark.dk/ - Other means (if any): Remittances, credit cards, regular incomes generated by property can also be submitted			
	Round trip ticket. Flight/train/ferry reservation with fixed travel dates of maximum 90 days to Denmark and other Schengen countries. (Do not buy the ticket until a visa has been granted).			
	Original compulsory travel medical insurance , covering the entire of intended stay, valid for all Schengen countries covering any medical expenses of at least 30,000 Euro as well as urgent medical attention, emergency hospital treatment or death during your stay, repatriation to Vietnam/resident country			

Note: Official documents marked with * must be verified by the competent local authority. Verification must be maximum 3 months old. A certified translation in English must be attached to any documents in Vietnamese.
