

## Checklist for visa application | Tourism

Applications should be submitted in person (also babies and children) and the following documents must be submitted:

- For every document, you must provide the original and one copy.
- The documents are to be presented in (or translated to) Dutch, English, French or Spanish.

•	The documents submitted will not be returned. Only the travel document will be returned
1.	Application
1.1	A completed and signed Schengen visa application form.

2.	Travel Documents
2.1	A passport or other travel document.

•	Your passport or travel document must be valid for at least 3 months from the date on which you leave the Schengen area.  Your passport or travel document must have at least 2 empty visa pages.  Your passport or travel document cannot have been issued more than 10 years ago.
2.3	Minors travelling without parents/guardians or with one parent/guardian only: Consent of parental authority or legal guardianship.

3.	Evidence of legal residence
3.1	For travelers returning to Canada:

Original of valid Canadian permanent residence or visa (valid for at least three months after the date of re-entry).

3.2	For travelers proceeding to onward travel (not returning to Canada), after leaving the Schengen area:  Travel reservation (plane/train ticket) and relevant visa or travel document authorizing entry into country of destination.

4.1	A passport photo that meets Dutch passport requirements. This photo cannot have been taken more than 6 months ago and must bear a clear resemblance.  See: <a href="mailto:photo-guidelines.">photo-guidelines.</a>

Note: r	make travel reservations which you can cancel, in case your visa request will be refused.
5.1	Proof of travel arrangements. Flight (roundtrip)/travel reservations or other proof of intended transport and full itinerary, if several Member States, Member States not applying the common visa policy for third countries.

5.2	Individuals: confirmed hotel reservations, stating name, address and telephone number of the hotel, including confirmation number.

	c) traveller's cheques
	d) salary slips
	e) certificate of employment
	f) registered proof of sponsorship and/or private accommodation.

5.5	Travelling for the purpose of business: If applicable, letter stating that all expenses are fully covered (e.g. a written proof that the inviting employer/company pays the expenses or alternatively the sending employer/company pays for all expenses).

5.6	In case of self-employment: Business registration and/or proof of funds.
