

FAQ for applicants

Can I still apply for a visa to Denmark?

You can still apply for a visa to Denmark. However only foreign travelers with a valid visa AND an essential purpose (anerkendelsesværdigt formål) for the visit will be allowed to enter Denmark.

I applied for a visa already but I have not received a decision, what will happen to my application?

If you have a pending visa application, your application will be submitted (forelagt) to the Danish Immigration Service (Udlændingestyrelsen) for consideration. This means that the case processing times will be prolonged.

Can I get a refund for my visa fee if I want to withdraw my visa application?

Applicants who wish to withdraw their application and who handed in the application before 14 March can get a refund of the visa application fee.

Can I enter Denmark, if I already have a valid Schengen visa?

Entry into Denmark has been restricted which means that you can only enter Denmark if you have a valid visa AND an essential purpose (anerkendelsesværdigt formål) for the visit. Essential purposes includes travelers who are either parents or primary caretakers of minors residing in Denmark (e.g. foster parents), visits to critically ill family members, persons who are in the process of a medical treatment in Denmark, persons who are attending a funeral in Denmark, and persons who will be part of a court case in Denmark.

Can I still apply for a work or residence permit?

Yes, and if you already hold a valid work or residence permit you can enter Denmark despite of the entry restrictions
