New E-Visa and E-Tourist Card service launched for a smarter and faster entry into Suriname

- The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Suriname and VFS Global partner to offer the new E-Visa and E-Tourist Card service for eligible travellers
- The New online platform offers quicker application and faster processing time
- The E-Visa applications to be submitted on https://suriname.vfsevisa.com/suriname/online/
- The E-Tourist Cards issued for tourism purposes are available on the same platform for travellers from 51 countries*

In line with the Government of Suriname's initiative to promote tourism and business, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs has partnered with VFS Global to offer the new E-Visa and E-Tourist Card service that will enable a faster and more convenient application, processing, and issuance of visa for leisure and business travellers. Visitors who are eligible to apply for one of the E-Visa categories will receive their travel authorisation from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs prior to their departure from their country of origin. E-Tourist Cards for tourism purposes are available on the same E-Visa platform and valid for a period of 90 days for a single visit. The new online service will be launched on 15 April, 2019.

Travellers can avail this simplified and seamless, highly secure online service by visiting https://suriname.vfsevisa.com/suriname/online/ from a location of their choice, instead of having to visit the Embassy or Consulate in person. With online payment options available, travellers also can use the save and retrieve option for completing the form at a later stage. On arrival in Suriname, this also ensures a faster process at the airport, since there will be no more need to enter separate queues for Visa or Tourist Card services.

E-Visa applications are available for five visa categories and travel authorisation will be granted prior an applicant travels to Suriname. E-Tourist Cards are eligible for nationals of 51 countries*) and will be provided fully electronically prior arrival on the same platform. No more paper form filling for a landing card is needed anymore on arrival.

3 SIMPLE STEPS TO GET YOUR SURINAME eVISA OR eTOURIST CARD

STEP 1: Go to https://suriname.vfsevisa.com/suriname/online/ and complete the registration process.

STEP 2: Complete the easy-to-use application form, seamlessly upload documents needed and proceed for online payment.

STEP 3: On the successful completion of the payment and once the visa decision is made, travellers will be informed about the outcome via email (for eVisa categories). The E-Visa or E-Tourist Card, if approved, will be provided electronically after application.
