Flexibility in visa rules, enhanced health precautions for students travelling to the UK for new academic year

- UK Visas and Immigration has introduced greater flexibility in visa rules, allowing students to commence study remotely, then apply for visas when they are able to travel to the UK.
- Students can now apply up to 6 months before they are due to start their course in the UK.
- Students studying courses online will still be eligible to apply for the Graduate route, provided they are in the UK by 6 April 2021 to complete their course and meet the other requirements of the route.
- As of 5 October, the UK launched a new and improved Student Route, which falls under the UK's new points based immigration system. This single global system will provide a more streamlined experience for international students.

As part of its commitment to enhance the visa experience for students, United Kingdom Visas and Immigration (UKVI) has introduced flexibility in visa rules, with health precautions throughout the visa system along with visa services partner VFS Global, to ensure a comfortable and safe environment for all customers.

Students who begin courses online can apply for visa later

Whilst we know that many students in the region have been able to apply for their student visa, to limit disruption caused by ongoing COVID-19 travel restrictions, UKVI is allowing incoming international students to apply for study (Tier 4) visa when they are due to travel to the UK, rather than the start of their course. This means students who have already gained admission can begin their courses online remotely and apply for a UK study visa when they are ready to do so.

Health precautions across the visa system

In order to ensure a safe environment for customers and employees, VFS Global has established standardised protective measures to be followed across all its UK Visa Application Centres. To ensure health safety norms are followed, the centres have implemented a mandatory appointment system and are maintaining physical distancing measures. Additionally, staff also carry out preventive measures such as disinfecting high-contact surfaces, body temperature screenings, use of hand sanitisers, etc.

'On-Demand Mobile Visa'* to apply for a visa at your doorstep

All visa customers, including students, can avail of the optional On-Demand Mobile Visa service* that enables them to submit their visa application and enrol biometrics from the comfort and safety of their home. New Graduate route policy enhanced

The new <u>Graduate route</u> will allow students who successfully complete a undergraduate or postgraduate degree to stay and work, look for work, and gain experience in the UK for two years (three years for PhD students). The route will be launched in Summer 2021, and students who start their courses online overseas will be eligible to apply for the Graduate route provided they are in the UK before 6 April 2021 and complete their course in the UK. The Graduate route was announced in September 2019 and will help the UK attract and retain the best international graduates, ensuring those graduates have the opportunity to secure skilled jobs and contribute to the UK's economic growth.

New and improved Student Route, replacing the Tier 4 process

The new and improved Student Route, the first of the UK's new points-based immigration system to launch, is now open for applications. The Student route improves on the previous Tier 4 route, making for a more streamlined experience for international students. The new route includes the option for students to apply for their visa six months in advance, compared to three months under the former Tier 4 system. Visas that have been issued through the Tier 4 route are still valid and those eligible will still be able to apply for the Graduate route when it opens in summer 2021.

According to data from UKVI, in the year ending June 2020, almost 3,800 student visas in total to the UK were granted to nationals from:

- Colombia (Almost 600 applications, 99% of all who applied were successful);
- Peru (More than 300 applications, 99% of all who applied were successful);
- Brazil (Almost 900 applications, 99% of all who applied were successful);
- Chile
 – (Almost 600 applications, 99% of all who applied were successful);
- Argentina (More than 100 applications, 99% of all who applied were successful);
- Mexico (More than 1,200 applications, 99% of all who applied were successful);
- Panama (More than 60 applications, 98% of all who applied were successful);
- Venezuela (More than 80 applications, 99% of all who applied were successful);

Since August 2020, UK Visa Application Centres have re-opened in countries across South America in a phased manner: Brazil (in Sao Paolo, Brasilia and Rio de Janeiro), Colombia (Bogota, Medellin and Cali), Venezuela (Caracas); Argentina (Buenos Aires); Peru (Lima), Mexico (Mexico City), Boliva (La Paz) Ecuador (Quito and Guayaquil), and Guatemala as an ODMV location – and these centres are receiving Tier 4 applications. All of the above locations are operational subject to local lockdown regulations.

Commenting on this, Martin Potter, Head of Customer Experience and Account Management for UK Visas and Immigration, said: "Over the last few years we have continued to see thousands of students from across South America choose the UK's world-class higher-education system as the destination for their studies. Despite the uncertainty of the COVID-19 pandemic, it is important we provide international students with the support and flexibility they need to pursue their studies in the UK, in a safe manner."

"For those travellers, our message is clear: your safety is our highest priority. Throughout the visa application process and your travel to the UK, we are taking measures to ensure you are safe and secure. In addition, the new Graduate route is guaranteed to open next summer – meaning those students heading to the UK this autumn will be able to apply for two years additional post-study leave to kick start their career in the UK."

Commenting on this, Vinay Malhotra, Regional Group Chief Operating Officer (South Asia, Middle East, North Africa and Americas), said: "As borders re-open and travel resumes, we are committed to maintaining the highest standards of health and safety precautions according to the guidelines of the World Health Organisation and local authorites. We are conscious that this is the time students will be applying for visas to travel to the UK for higher education, and would like to reassure them of a safe and seamless visa application process at our Centres or via the On Demand Mobile Visa service that customers can use to submit visa applications from their locations of choice."
