IMPORTANT
(A) If marriage is solemnized in Foreign country, marriage certificate should be attested/certified by concerned Indian Mission/Post
(B) All applicants who are applying for OCI card on spouse basis under section 7A (1) (d) of Citizenship Act, 1955 need to come to the Embassy first for personal interview. Such applications will be accepted by VFS only after personal interviews and recommendation of the Embassy. Timing for personal interview is between 9:30 AM and 11:30 AM on all working days.
(C) All necessary documents issued by French authorities must be duly translated by a sworn translator and apostilled by "Cour d' appel".
( <b>D</b> ) It is mandatory for all applicants to give biometrics at VFS at the time of submission of their OCI application. ( <b>E</b> ) Applicants who were born in India after 01.07.1987 but never held Indian passport must submit Indian origin proof of their parents along with their own birth certificate.
