### APPLICANTS SHOULD PROVIDE <u>AT LEAST</u> ONE DOCUMENT TO PROVE LINKAGE AND <u>AT LEAST</u> ONE DOCUMENT TO PROVE THE INDIAN ORIGIN OF THE FAMILY MEMBER CONCERNED

#### Documents to prove linkage with their parents/grandparents or spouse.

- Birth certificate issued from competent authority mentioning both parents name. In case the birth certificate is issued by a foreign authority, it is to be apostilled or endorsed by the concerned Indian Mission abroad/concerned Foreign Mission in India.
  - **Note**:- if the parents are divorced, court order of dissolution of marriage, which specifically mentions that the legal custody of the child is with the parent, who is applying for OCI card.
- Copy of marriage certificate (if applying on the basis of spouse). Please note that the marriage must have been registered and subsisted for a continuous period of not less than two years.

#### **IMPORTANT**

- (A) If marriage is solemnized in Foreign country, marriage certificate should be attested/certified by concerned Indian Mission/Post
- **(B)** All applicants who are applying for OCI card on spouse basis under section 7A (1) (d) of Citizenship Act, 1955 need to come to the Embassy first for personal interview. Such applications will be accepted by VFS only after personal interviews and recommendation of the Embassy. Timing for personal interview is between 9:30 AM and 11:30 AM on all working days.
- (C) All necessary documents issued by French authorities must be duly translated by a sworn translator and apostilled by "Cour d' appel".
- (**D**) It is mandatory for all applicants to give biometrics at VFS at the time of submission of their OCI application.
- (E) Applicants who were born in India after 01.07.1987 but never held Indian passport must submit Indian origin proof of their parents along with their own birth certificate.
