●Suspension of visa efficacy, designation of country to be denied entry...

The efficacy of visa issued on or before 2nd April 2020 is still under suspension. India was designated as entry denied country on 27th May 2020.

New issuance of visas with "EX-R" in its remarks column has suspended from 28th December 2020.

Foreign nationals who stayed in India within 14 days prior to application for landing into Japan may not enter Japan after on 4 January, 2021, even if they possess a visa with "EX-R" in its remarks column.

●The extension of validity of COE

COE issued on or after 1st October 2019 is extended valid term till following date.

In order for COE to be considered to be valid, at the time of visa application, submit the document from institution stating that applicant is still required as per status mentioned on the COE.

• Issued date from 1st Oct. 2019 to 31st Dec. 2019 → valid until 30th Apr. 2021 (as same as previous condition)

• Issued date from 1st Jan. 2020 to 30th Jan. 2021 → valid until 31st Jul. 2021

• Issued date on or after 31st Jan. 2021 → valid 6months from issued date

●Acquisition of covid negative certificate and quarantine measure

All passenger need to get certificate of negative COVID-19 test result conducted within 72 hours of the departure time of the flight (format is on the MOFA Homepage).

On arrival to Japan, all the passengers are required to take COVID-19 test, and do not use public transport as well as 14 days of home quarantine etc. (the detail is on the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare Homepage) is mandatory.
