1.	One (1) completed and signed (by the applicant) visa application form duly filled in legibly in English.			
2.	Passport valid for at least three months after the expiry date of the visa being requested and containing at least two blank pages.			
3.	Passport photocopy of the bio-data page and other pages that have observations, visa stickers or stamps. Previous passports, if any, should also be photocopied in the same manner.			
4.	Two (2) recent passport-size photographs bearing a true likeness to the applicant taken against a white background, with face clearly visible.			
7.	Invitation letter issued by the EU national in Malta clearly stating that the family member will be accompanying or travelling with the EU national.			
8.	Proof of relation with an EU national residing in Malta (e.g. marriage certificate, birth certificate, etc.)			<p>If the document has been issued by Maltese authorities then only a copy of the document is needed.</p> <p>Documents issued by the Filipino authorities should be legalised at the Department of Foreign Affairs. Where the document is not in English, a translation in English (or Maltese) is to be provided.</p>
9.	Copy of ID Card or Passport of EU national and proof of residence in Malta of the EU national (e.g. residence permit).			
10	<b>FOR MINORS (UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE):</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• DSWD Clearance (if travelling alone or without parent/s)</li> <li>• Affidavit of Support and Consent notarized and legalized by Department of Foreign Affairs.</li> <li>• Birth Certificate</li> </ul>

The applicant is hereby informed that submitting the above-mentioned documents does not guarantee the automatic issuance of a visa. It is also important to note that original certificates submitted with applications may not in all cases be returned.
