

Checklist for visa application | Study or other types of training

Applications should be submitted in person (also babies and children) and the following documents must be submitted:

- For every document, you must provide the original and one copy.
- The documents are to be presented in (or translated to) Dutch, English, French or Spanish.
- The documents submitted will not be returned. Only the travel document will be returned.

1.1	A completed and signed Schengen visa application form.

•	Your passport or travel document must be valid for at least 3 months from the date on which you leave the Schengen area. Your passport or travel document must have at least 2 empty visa pages. Your passport or travel document cannot have been issued more than 10 years ago.
2.3	If the applicant is a minor:
	If the minor travels with only parent only, written consent of the other parent or guardian, except in cases of a parent having the care or custody alone*;

3.	Evidence of legal residence
3.1	Evidence of legal residence in the country you are applying from, e.g. a passport, visa or residence permit and a copy of work permit (if applicable). Residence permit should be valid for at least 3 months after departure from Schengen.

4.1	A passport photo that meets Dutch passport requirements. This photo cannot have been taken more than 6 months ago and must bear a clear resemblance. See: photo guidelines.

5.	Proof of travel

5.1	Proof of lodging: hotel reservations, rental of holiday home, campus residence reservation or if stay with a family member or friend, proof of private accommodation (invitation) from the host.
