1	Cover letter from the Application Portal Norway – https://selfservice.udi.no			
2	One (1) photograph glued to cover letter.(biometrical standard, not older than 6 months, 35 x 45 mm.)			
3	Invitation (written in Norwegian or English). The invitation letter must signed by the reference (the one inviting). The invitation letter should come from the main person that you are going to visit. Examples: your biological family member, your spouse/fiancée, boy -or girlfriend, etc.			
4	If the applicant does not have sustainable economic means/income, original “Guarantee Form (Garantiskjema for besøk)” stamped by the Police in Norway has to be submitted in original.			
5	Copy of the reference’s passport. If the applicant intends to visit a friend, fiancé, boy- or girlfriend, include pages showing entry and exit stamps from former travels to Turkey. If the sponsor has a residence permit in Norway; copy of reference's Residence card			
6	If the applicant intends to visit his/her fiancé or boy/girlfriend, a photo taken together (in A4-format).			
7	Letter granting Power of Attorney. (Optional for applicants who want the reference or other person to represent them in the case.)			
8	Proof of the existence of family relations (Tam Tekmil Vukuatlı Nüfus Kayıt Örneği). In original. It is NOT necessary with English translation.			
9	If the applicant is employed: Permission letter from employer and approval for leave (in original on company stationary in English or with sworn English translation), pay slips for the last three months, SGK entrance registration, SGK statements for the last three months and Certificate of Activity from the employer			
10	If the applicant is a farmer; farmer certificate issued by chamber of agriculture.			
11	If the applicant is an employer or owner of a private company: company registration in chamber of commerce, Certificate of Activity, Tax Chart, Turkish Trade Registry Gazette			
12	If the applicant is retired: proof of pension (either bank account statement or pensioner booklet)			
13	If the applicant is a student: student certificate in original in English or translated by sworn translator(Öğrenci Belgesi)			
14	Updated bank account statement of the applicant in original, showing the movements of last three months.(signed and stamped by bank)			
15	If the applicant is a minor or under age 18 and travelling alone or with one parent or legal guardian only: public notary approved statement from his/her parents (this condition shall not apply if the travelling parent can document that he/she is a single parent or holds the parental authority alone) (in English or with sworn English translation).			
16	Passport (both new and old passport(s) if any). Please make sure that your passport is valid for at least three months beyond your intended stay in Norway, and that the passport has at least two blank pages for a visa sticker.)			
17	Copy of your passport (All the issued pages and front photographed page must be copied in colored A4 format, for foreigners: valid resident/- work permits in Turkey also must be copied).			
18	Flight or travel reservations or other proof of intended transport. (It is not necessary to buy the ticket until a visa has been granted.)			
19	Compulsory travel medical insurance, covering all Schengen countries (minimum coverage is 30,000 EU)			
20	If you are visiting family other than spouse: Questionnaire B - filled out and signed			
21	If you are visiting friend, boyfriend/girlfriend, fiancée, spouse: Questionnaire C - filled out and signed			

Declaration

The Norwegian Embassy has the right to ask for additional documents, and an interview of the applicant. I am aware of that paying the application fee does not entitle me to a visa. In case of refusal, the visa fee is not refundable.
