Applicants who have obtained Indian passport after three months of obtaining Foreign / French nationality will be issued passport "Revocation Certificate" instead of passport "Surrender Certificate", for obtaining Indian passport by suppressing material information about their having foreign nationality and not being eligible for Indian passport. A revocation certificate is not acceptable for applying OCI card [Except those hailing from erstwhile Portuguese territories of India (Goa, Daman, Diu)].
