



AUSTRIA - CHECKLIST FOR FAMILY MEMBERS OF A CITIZEN OF THE EUROPEAN UNION OR A STATE OF THE EUROPEAN ECONOMIC AREA OR SWITZERLAND

Check Box	List of Requisite Documents	Remarks
	Schengen Visa Application Form: Each applicant must complete and sign an official application form, filling in each of its sections. If the applicant is a minor, one of their parents must sign the application.	
	One recent photograph: Note: Passport size with white or plain light colour background; must be a recent photograph (not older than 6 months); without dark or reflective glasses or any head covering for male applicants. The size of the photograph should be 35mm by 45mm and the height between the foreheads till the chin should be 36mm.	
	Valid, unexpired passport: Original and a photocopy of the page or pages of the passport that contain biometric data. The passport must be signed by the holder and must be valid at least three months beyond the planned departure date from the Schengen territory. It must also contain at least two blank pages. Passports issued more than 10 years ago will not be accepted.	
	Documents proving family relationship with a citizen of the European Union or a State of the European Economic Area or Switzerland: Civil registry certificates (birth or marriage, accordingly), certificate of registration as an unmarried couple or any other document proving that the partnership is analogous to a marital relationship.	
	In the case of descendants over 21, ascendant relatives or other relatives, documents proving they are in the care of a citizen of the European Union or a State of the European Economic Area or Switzerland or, if applicable, their state of health.	
	Documents proving that the applicant is travelling with a citizen of the European Union or a State of the European Economic Area or Switzerland or is on the way to joining them.	

Please note:

- All documentations must be submitted in English language.
- All applicants must be present to provide their biometrics.
- For children registered in a parent's passport, a separate application form along with the required documents has to be submitted. Original documents must be presented; additional photocopies may be required.
