

VISA FOR FAMILY REUNION FOR CHILDREN (up to 21 years old) WITH A BELGIAN PARENT OR A FLIPINO PARENT WHO IS THE SPOUSE/PARTNER OF A BELGIAN CITIZEN (Visa D)

The complete file should be lodged in 3 sets: 1 original and 2 copies

Please arrange your documents according to this checklist

A. General requirements:

- 1. Visa application form duly completed and signed;
- 2. Passport with validity of at least 3 months longer than the validity period of the D visa (9 months);
- 3. Copy of the data page of the passport together with all pages having visas and stamps;
- 4. One (1) passport sized photo with white background and not older than 6 months;

Please note: No visa application fee has to be paid

B. Supporting documents:

From the parents to be joined in Belgium

- ⇒ Proof of identity of the parent and of his/her Belgian spouse/partner (if any) (copy of both ID cards)
- \Rightarrow Proof of marriage or official cohabitation of the parent and Belgian spouse/partner (if any)
- ⇒ Family composition certificate issued by the municipality in Belgium
- ⇒ Proof of registered and sufficient lodging
- ⇒ Proof of certificate of Health Insurance (click here for more information);
- ⇒ Proof of regular, stable and sufficient income covering one year prior to submission of the visa application (salary slips, last income tax assessment paper from the Finance Department in Belgium, etc.)

From the visa applicant

- ⇒ Birth Certificate issued on Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Security Paper with DFA apostille
- 1. If the child is minor (below 18 years old)

⇒ Proof of custody. If the name of both biological parents are mentioned in the birth certificate:

Visa for Belgium

- o applicant has to get an Affidavit of Consent from the parent living in the Philippines allowing him/her to live permanently with his/her parent in Belgium. This document must have a DFA apostille o in the absence of an Affidavit of Consent, a court judgment giving sole custody to the parent in Belgium must be submitted. The court judgment must have a finality decree with DFA apostille
- if the parent in the Philippines is deceased, death certificate issued on Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Security Paper with DFA apostille
- 2. If the child is between 18 and 21 years old:

⇒ proof of payment of contribution fee

The processing of this visa D applications will require payment of an extra contribution to be deposited directly in a bank account in Belgium prior to the submission of the application file. Carefully read the information HERE.

- ⇒ Proof of Civil Status
 - Certificate of Non-Appearance in the National Indices of Marriage (CENOMAR) issued on Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Security Paper with DFA apostille OR
 - $_{\odot}$ marriage certificate issued on $\,$ Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Security Paper with DFA apostille
