

VISA FOR WORK (Visa D)

The complete file should be lodged in 2 sets

Please arrange your documents according to this checklist

A. General requirements:

- 1. Visa application form dully completed and signed;
- 2. Passport with validity of at least 3 months longer than the validity period of the D visa (15 months);
- 3. Copy of the data page of the passport together with all pages having visas and stamps;
- 4. One (1) passport sized photo with white background and not older than 6 months;
- 5. Non-refundable visa application fee to be paid upon submission of visa application;

B. Supporting documents:

- ⇒ Letter of authorisation to work and stay (single permit) * from the competent authorities in Belgium
- ⇒ Note: An email confirmation should be received by the Embassy from the Issuing Authority in Belgium prior to lodging of the visa application.

^{*} As from 01/01/2019, third-country nationals wishing to work in Belgium for more than 90 days should apply to the competent region, through their employer, for a single application for a work permit and at the same time an application for a residence permit. If the work permit / residence permit are granted respectively by the Region and Immigration Office, the third-country national will receive a **single permit** certifying that he is allowed to stay more than 90 days in Belgium to work there.
