FAMILY REUNION WITH A BELGIAN - ART 40 TER

- It is essential that the file contains the original documents, plus two (2) photocopies of these documents. The originals will be returned to the applicant
- Applicants who cannot enclose all documents from the list should consider adding alternatives or explain the reasons for not providing them
- During the examination of the application the Embassy may request additional documents which are not mentioned in below list and may call the applicant for an interview
- Documents issued by local authorities must be legalized by the Ministry Foreign Affairs and afterwards by the Belgian Embassy
- Any documents submitted in languages other than English, French, Dutch or German will not be considered
- Applicants are hereby informed that submission of the below-mentioned documents doesn't guarantee automatic issuance of a visa
- In principle, the processing time varies between 1-3weeks. If the visa application has to be submitted to the Home office in Brussels for decision, then the processing time will be approximately between 1-6 months
- Processing time differs from case to case. Therefore, in order to avoid delays, it is advisable to apply well
 in advance before the departure date
- Applicants have the possibility to apply for a visa already six months in advance and at least 15 days before the travelling date
- An incomplete file will most probably lead to a visa refusal
- Visa fees are non-refundable

For spouses

- The original marriage certificate along with its translation (If necessary) in the notarized and legalized form
- o A birth certificate of the applicant
- In case of divorce or widowhood: a notarized and legalized certificate of divorce/death of the spouse
- For children under 18 years of age
 - A birth certificate mentioning the name of both parents along with its translation (If necessary) in the notarized and legalized form
 - In case the parents are divorced: a true certified, notarized and legalized copy of the divorce decision mentioning to whom of the parents the full guardianship was entrusted, together with a notarized and legalized authorization from the parent, stating that the child can permanently leave with a copy of the parent ID;
 - o In case the child was adopted: a notarized and legalized adoption certificate;
 - In case a parent has deceased: a notarized and legalized death certificate of the deceased parent.
- Children aged 18 years and over
 - o A notarized and legalized birth certificate mentioning the name of both parents
- Children aged 21 years and over
 - o A notarized and legalized birth certificate mentioning the name of both parents
 - o Proof that the child is dependent on the person in Belgium

PROOF OF SUFFICIENT ACCOMODATION YES NO

Proof that the party being joined has sufficient accommodation: this evidence can be done either by a
copy of the property's title assigned to his/her principal residence, or by a copy of a registered lease
contract concerning his/her principal residence.

PROOF OF SOVENCY OF THE PERSON TO BE JOINED YES NO

Proof that the person being joined has stable, regular and sufficient means of subsistence: the proof
must concern the last 12 months and the amount must meet his/her own needs and those of the
members of his/her family and avoid them becoming a burden on the public authorities

MUTUAL INSURANCE COMPANY YES NO

 Proof that the person to be joined is affiliated to a Mutual Health Insurance Company (Mutualiteit / Mutualité) covering the risks for himself/herself
