		pupils must be between 8 and 10 mm, white background). Any alterations (like Photoshop etc.) are strictly forbidden.
3.		Valid passport
		At least two free pages, validity of at least 90 days after expiration of Visa requested and at least 6 months from the
		date of submission; duly signed.
4.		Round Trip air ticket booking Document must be in English language, must be issued by airline or travel agency, must report full name of applicant
		as per passport.
5.		Journalist documentation:
		A certificate or other document issued by a professional organization or the applicant's employer proving that the
		person concerned is a qualified journalist and stating that the purpose of the journey is to carry out journalistic work or proving that the person is a member of the technical crew accompanying the journalist in a professional capacity.
6.		Hotel booking
		Document must be in English language, reservations must cover the whole duration of the trip, document must contain
		hotel name, hotel address, name of the applicant as per passport. In case of additional touristic travel: Complete itinerary
7.		Dates, cities, transports used to move across Schengen Area, if travelling to Non-Schengen Country during same trip,
		transport ticket and valid visa (for the Non-Schengen country) are needed.
8.		Proof of financial situation in country of residence
		Personal account statement of the last three months updated to maximum 7 days before date of submission. No fixed
		accounts. Or Thai Company, employing the applicant, statement of the last 3 months updated to maximum 7 days before date of submission. No fixed accounts.
		Evidence of applicant's employment
9.		If applicant is an employee : Original employment letter, reporting Full name of applicant, Job position of applicant,
		Salary of applicant, Period of leave, Years of service in the company, Company stamp, Signature of manager, Full address of company, Telephone number of company. Letter's date of issue must be within 30 days.
		If applicant is business owner: Business License (from DBD) valid for 90 days together with English translation.
10.		Overseas medical insurance
		Must cover whole period of stay, must report full name of applicant as per passport, must be valid for the whole Schengen
		Area, minimum coverage of 30.000 Euro for urgent hospitalization or repatriation expenses, stamp and signature of insurance company are mandatory.

11.		Only for Non-Thai citizens: work permit, Re-entry Permit.
		Thai Visa validity MUST be minimum 1 year and 1 day.
		Original and copy, Re-Entry permit from Thai Immigration valid after coming back from Schengen States.
12.		(If applicable) Name Change Certificate
		Original and copy, translation in English.
13.		Two copies of applicant's passport's first page and copies of previous visas issued in the last 5 years by Schengen, UK, USA, or Canada.
		If Visas are in old passport: copy of first page of old passport and copies of relevant visas.
	<u> </u>	if visus are at ola passport: copy of fast page of ola passport and copies of relevant visus.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

After applying for the Visa, the applicants will not be able to collect their passports from the Embassy. The processing time for a Visa application is maximum 15 calendar days according to Visa Schengen Code. Need of interviews or other issues might extend this period.

The Consular administration has full authority to evaluate and request additional documentation, if deemed necessary, in addition to what is submitted. Furthermore, the applicant is hereby informed that submitting all required documentation does NOT guarantee the issuance of any particular visa.
