8	Dispatch letter from the cultural or sports organisation in Japan on official letterhead, incl. stamp, signature, and date with the following details:  1) Organisation's full address and telephone number;  2) Applicant's name, position, salary, and years of service (for professionals);  3) Sponsor for travel and living costs;  4) Confirmation of participation; and  5) Name and position of the signing officer.	
9	Personal bank statements showing movements from the last three months, with your name matching your passport, residence certificate (住民票), or valid residence card (在留力一ド). Personal bank statements are required from all applicants above 18 years old regardless of sponsorship or student status. Fixed deposit accounts are not considered. Not ensuring sufficient funds may lead to a refusal.  Staying at a private home, you must have DKK 350 per day at your disposal.  Staying at a hotel, you must have DKK 500 per day at your disposal.	
10	Invitation letter from host(s). Using the <u>online invitation form</u> (VU3) on <u>newtodenmark.dk</u> , typically reduces processing time. For visits to multiple organisations, additional invitation letters must be provided.
