

## Schengen visa | Checklist for Applicants under Directive 2004/38/EC

This category is only for EU/EEA citizen's family members who are residing in the UK and travelling to an EU Member State of which the EU citizen is NOT a national of. The family member must travel with or join the EU/EEA citizen.

Please note that Estonian citizen's family members cannot apply under this category and must instead apply under Private (family, friends) visit or other categories.

Documents issued by a foreign country must be translated into Estonian or English and certified with an apostille or legalised. Documents issued in the UK must be certified with an apostille: <https://www.gov.uk/get-document-legalised>. Originals shall be presented in Visa Application Centre (VAC). Please be prepared to show original documents at the VAC, but only submit photocopies of documents. The embassy will not return any documents to the applicant other than the passport. Supporting documents shall be presented in the following order.

Required Documents	YES/NO	Remarks
<b>Valid travel document.</b> Travel documents issued 10 years prior to the date of submitting the application are not accepted. The travel document must be valid at least three months after the completion of the journey. Travel document must contain two blank pages.		
<b>Schengen visa <a href="#">ONLINE</a> application form</b> duly completed. The printout must be dated and signed by the applicant.		
<b>Recent colour passport photograph</b> , taken within the past six (6) months, white or light background, neutral face expression.		
<b>Proof of UK residency:</b> Share code for UK immigration status + status printout; <a href="https://www.gov.uk/view-prove-immigration-status">https://www.gov.uk/view-prove-immigration-status</a> . Residency status in the UK must be valid for at least <b>one (1) month beyond</b> the intended departure from the Schengen area.		
<b>Copy of the passport of ID-card of the family member who is an EU citizen.</b>		
<b>Marriage certificate, full birth certificate or other official documentation of family relationship</b> (certified with an apostille or legalised, see above).		
<b>Proof of travelling with or to join the EU citizen</b> (free choice of proof, e.g., flight or hotel reservations in both names, letter from the EU citizen etc.).		

Processing time for Schengen visa applications is 15 calendar days, in accordance with the Visa Code. The period is calculated from the Thursday following the appointment date.
