

Long-stay D-type visa | Checklist for Working Holiday Visa (for citizens of Canada)

NB! Working visas are issued to Canadian citizens aged 18–35, who can stay in Estonia for up to a year (12 months).

Documents issued by a foreign country must be translated into Estonian or English and certified with an apostille or legalised. Documents issued in the UK must be certified with an apostille: <https://www.gov.uk/get-document-legalised>. Originals shall be presented in Visa Application Centre (VAC). Please be prepared to show original documents at the VAC, but only submit photocopies of documents. The embassy will not return any documents to the applicant other than the passport. Supporting documents shall be presented in the following order.

Required Documents	YES/NO	Remarks
Valid travel document and one photocopy of it. Travel documents issued 10 years prior to the date of submitting the application are not accepted. The travel document must be valid at least three months after the completion of the journey. Travel document must contain two blank pages.		
Long-stay D-visa ONLINE application form duly completed. The printout must be dated and signed (<i>three signatures required</i>) by the applicant.		
Recent colour passport photograph , taken within the past six (6) months, white or light background, neutral face expression.		
Valid health insurance policy including hospitalisation and repatriation , which must be valid for the whole duration of the stay.		
Proof of confirmed flight ticket to Estonia and return ticket or of sufficient means to cover the costs of a return flight ticket.		
Cover letter confirming the intent for the visa.		
As the case may be: (i) show that they have obtained a pre-arranged contract of employment in support of their career development; or (ii) provide documentation proving registration at a post-secondary institution in their home country and that they have obtained a pre-arranged internship or work placement; or (iii) confirm their intention to travel in the host country and work in order to supplement their financial resources.		
Proof of funds: recent (last three (3) months) of bank statements. Cash is not accepted.		

Processing time for long-stay D-visa applications is 30 calendar days. The period is calculated from the Thursday following the appointment date.
