

## White Card (digital nomad)

1.	▪ <b>Application form and Appendix no. 9.18 duly filled out in English and signed by the applicant on site upon application with blue ink pen.</b>
2.	▪ <b>One recent passport picture</b> <i>Photo must be: 35 mm wide, 45 mm high, photo must be well contrasted, person must look straight into the camera, head must be straight, not tilted, mouth closed.</i>
3.	▪ <b>Valid passport (plus one photocopy of biometric page)</b> <i>At least two empty visa pages, the passport must be valid for at least three months after the intended date of departure from the territory of the Member States and the travel document shall have been issued within the previous 10 years.</i>
4.	▪ <b>Proof of right to reside in the UK (plus one photocopy of back and front)</b> <i>Original and copy of residence permit or British passport.</i>
5.	▪ <b>Documents verifying the purpose of residence may be verified by:</b> a) <b>In the case of employment in a country other than Hungary, a certified statement from your employer stating:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>· the scope of the employer's activities,</li><li>· the provision on remote, electronic work and its authorised duration, and</li><li>· the duties and the position of the applicant.</li></ul> <i>Proof of the real and actual operation of the employer must be certified.</i> b) <b>if the applicant runs a company with proven profits from Hungary, a document stating:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>· the real and actual operation of the company,</li><li>· the job title and position held by the applicant in the company,</li><li>· the scope of the company's activities, and</li><li>· his/her ownership of shares in the company.</li></ul> <b>The real and actual operation of the company can be verified by:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>· a document certifying the registration of the company by the public authorities,</li><li>· an authentic instrument or a certificate from the tax authorities proving regular income or profit,</li><li>· other credible means.</li></ul>
6.	▪ <b>Documents in proof of means of subsistence in Hungary:</b> <i>The third-country national is considered to have sufficient resources to cover his/her subsistence if the third-country national's monthly legal income is equal to or exceeds EUR 3,000 net for at least 6 months prior to entry.</i>  <i>The applicant must have this amount of income throughout the period of stay in Hungary.</i>  <b>The requirement of subsistence may be verified by:</b>

- bank statement for the previous 6 months,
- a certificate evidencing regular income issued by the employer or by the tax authority.

7. **Documents proving the existence of Hungarian accommodation** may be verified by:

- a residential lease contract,
- a document on accommodation by courtesy,
- a document in proof of ownership,
- documentary evidence to verify the reservation of accommodation and payment.

8. **Documents proving the existence of comprehensive health insurance**

Enclosed with the application for residence permit the applicant shall provide proof of having access to comprehensive health insurance services (in particular on the basis of specific other legislation on the social security system, international agreement, or under specific agreement), or that he/she has the necessary financial resources to cover the costs of such services.

9. **Documents evidencing the conditions of exit** may be verified by:

- a valid passport or the permits necessary for the third-country national for returning to his/her country of origin, or to the country he/she indicates;
- and a valid ticket for departure, or sufficient funds to purchase such a ticket, or a means of transport lawfully used by the third-country national.
