 - Signature/thumb impression of applicant should be on first and last page. Print out should be in a portrait mode. Each page on a separate sheet. ☐
- 2 One photograph conforming to Indian Government norms as per specifications mentioned on our website ☐
- 3 Self-attested copy of Dutch (foreign) passport ☐
- 4 Original Indian passport ☐
- 5 Self-attested copy of Indian passport (first and last page) ☐
 - In case the passport dates back to the 80s and 90s a copy of the first 4 pages is required
- 6 Copy of Naturalization certificate (Bekendmaking) or Uittreksel specifying the date when the applicant became a Dutch (foreign) citizen ☐
 - In case citizenship is different than Dutch, official document proving the date of acquisition of foreign nationality ☐
- 7 Affidavit for change in name (if applicable) ☐
- 8 Declaration form : to be filled by all applicants submitting any application ☐
