A declaration must be signed in front of the Consulate General, with a copy of the identity document, requesting the presence of the spouse in Italy and which attests that he/she shall be economically dependent on the principal applicant. To be done through the Consular Section by submitting the original Marriage Certificate issued by the Registrar of Marriages, Sub-Registrar, Tehsildar or Grama Panchayat, clearly mentioning the registration number. To be notarised and duly validated by the Under Secretary of the Home Department of the relevant/competent State Government & apostilled by the Ministry of External Affairs/ New Delhi.	
One and the same certificate	Original and photocopy to be collected, in case of any discrepancy in names. This has to be issued by the competent Tehsildar or Grama Panchayat, notarised, legalised by Home Department and apostilled by the Ministry of External Affairs/New Delhi.
