TOURIST VISAS FOR OMANI NATIONALS  
Documents required for Schengen Visa applications

<p><b>E-Application form</b> – duly completed on line, website <a href="http://e-applicationvisa.esteri.it">http://e-applicationvisa.esteri.it</a> . You need to print it, 4 pages and the bar code page, and sign it. If the applicant <b>is a minor</b> (under the age of 18) both parents/legal guardian must sign the application form. <b>Minor and both parents must be present</b> at the VFS center during the application process</p>
<p><b>Passport</b> - valid for at least 3 months from the date of return and there must be at least two blank pages in the document</p>
<p><b>Photocopy of relevant passport pages:</b> data page, previous Schengen , UK and USA visas</p>
<p>A recent passport sized <b>color photograph</b> with a white background (3.50X4.50cm). Head covering are only accepted for religious reasons, please see “ Photo Specification” link</p>
<p><b>Proof of accommodation during all the intended stay:</b> Hotel/s reservation/s, copy of a rental contract or proof of residential property</p>
<p><b>Flight</b> reservation or flight ticket including return flight. For internal travels or travel to other Schengen Country applicants must provide flight/train/car rental booking/s or reservation/s</p>
<p>Evidence of <b>sufficient means of subsistence during the intended stay:</b> Salary letter from the applicant’s employer OR Bank statement for the last three months, in original or photocopy with original bank stamp. For applicants who are self-employed also a valid original Commercial Registration Certificate.</p> <p><b>Unemployed/house wife/student applicants:</b> must submit a signed declaration of financial support (available at the “Download Forms” link) a copy of the passport and bank statement or salary letter from the person who is sponsoring the trip. Omani students who are currently studying abroad have to apply for their Schengen visa to the Italian Embassy in the country where they are resident for study reasons.</p>
<p>A copy of <b>medical insurance</b> covering a minimum of 30.000 Euros for emergency hospitalization and repatriation expenses valid throughout the Schengen area. The medical insurance has to cover the duration of your stay in Schengen States</p>
<p><b>If the applicant is a minor – Parental authorization</b> (available at the “Download Forms” link) signed by both parents/legal guardian authorizing the minor to travel and a photocopy of their passport. If one of the parents is abroad, he/she needs to contact the Visa Section of the Embassy by email: <a href="mailto:visti.mascate@esteri.it">visti.mascate@esteri.it</a></p>
