9	Proof of employment	Proof of employment as a nomad worker for 6 (six) months prior to requesting the visa. Current work contract			
10	Proof of Funds	In the form of Proof of earnings in excess of 25.000 Euros per year			
11	Proof of accommodation in Italy	Rental contract for a minimum period of 1 year or proof of ownership of property in Italy			
12	Proof of Residence in SA	In the form of a utility bill			
13	Proof of Payment	Copy of the VFS's receipt.
