1	Passport - <b><u>IF</u></b> applicant has refugee status, they <b><u>must</u></b> present the local Travel Document /Refugee passport issued from the South African Authorities - Ordinary passport is <b><u>NOT</u></b> accepted.	Must have a validity of at least 6 months prior to the returning date and 3 blank pages.			
2	Italian National D visa application Form	For a stay of longer than 90 days			
3	Color ID Photos (x2)	Can be done at VFS Global free of charge

6	Proof of Transport (LS)	<b><u>Confirmed</u></b> air ticket, or other mode of transport, proving the arrival into Italy.			
7	SUI LETTER	<b><u>Which will have to appear on the VISA system</u></b> The visa has to be issued within 6 months from the issuing of the SUI letter			
8	PROOF OF THE FAMILY STATUS	<b><u>In the form of a marriage or birth certificate,</u></b> in which the relationship with the foreign citizen resident in Italy with which the applicant will be re-joined, is proven.			
9	Proof of Payment	Copy of the VFS's receipt.
