- 8. For students Bonafide letter/certificate from school/institution.
- 9. Original NOC / Leave Approval letter from Company
- 10. Invitation letter from invitee.
- 11. Guarantee letter from invitee.
- 12. Day to Day itinerary
- 13. Relationship proof (government based) / (family chart)
- 14. Juuminhyou certificate of inviting person.
- 15. Residence card and passport copies of inviting person.
- 16. Tax certificate and Salary certificate.
- 17. employment certificate of inviting person (should be issued within 3months).
- 18. Tentative ticket booking copy (this should match the itinerary) (tickets from Bangalore both inward and outward)
- 19. Relatives working should provide a leave letter from their employer on their company letterhead.
- 20. If family or friends are travelling from Bangalore together, must submit their applications together.

- 21. If Applicant is Employee then Latest updated 3 Month Salary Bank Statement till the date of Submission of your application and Only IT Returns Acknowledgement for Latest (TWO) 2 years and latest pay slips (3months)
- 22. If Divorced, Divorce decree is required.
