# DOCUMENTS REQUIRED MEDICAL STAY VISA

## Important-All photocopies should be on A4 size only

Foreign patients seeking medical treatment or other medical services at a Japanese medical institution should refer to the lists of guarantors (e.g., medical coordinators, travel agencies) registered for this visa scheme. The lists are at the end of this document. Foreign patients should contact one of the guarantors and request arrangements for receiving medical services.

- A valid Passport (with more than two blank pages). Please submit your old passports also, if any.
- Photocopy of the Bio Data Page of the Current Passport (First and Last Page)
- A completely filled and signed Visa Application Form.
- One photograph taken within the last 6 months. (The photograph should be passport size with white background and printed on good quality paper)
- Covering letter (if any special explanation is needed)
- Latest Income Tax Return (if not available, bank statement of last 6 months)
- Certificate from a medical institution about the planned medical services and references from a guarantor.

- Certificate of Eligibility (when the foreign patient needs to stay longer than 90 days to be hospitalized and receive medical services)
- Medical Treatment Plan (when the foreign patient needs to make multiple visits to Japan to receive treatment)
