MULTIPLE 7 (Spouse or Children of Individual who has Employment Visa in Japan)

Important - All photocopies should be on A4 size only

Prepared by the Applicant

- A valid Passport (with more than two blank pages). Please submit your old passports also, if any.
- Photocopy of the Bio Data Page of the Current Passport (First and Last Page)
- A completely filled and signed Visa Application Form.
- One photograph taken within the last 6 months. (The photograph should be passport size with white background and printed on good quality paper)
- Covering letter (if any special explanation is needed)
- Document to show the flight schedule to/from Japan
- Latest Income Tax Return (if not available, bank statement of last 6 months)

Prepared by the Inviter/Guarantor in Japan

- Invitation Letter (with reason for applying multiple entry visa)
- Letter of Guarantee
- Document to prove kinship (Birth Certificate, Marriage certificate, etc.)
- Itinerary in Japan (including hotel information, contact information while in Japan)
- List of applicants (when there are multiple applicants)
- More than one of the following documents from the guarantor
 - A) Certificate of Income / Taxation issued by the head of administration of the place of residence, or certificate of tax payment (Form 2) issued by the director of the tax office.
 - Note: (1) Each certificate should indicate the gross income for the previous year.
 - Note: (2) Statement of Tax Withholding (Gensenchoshuhyo:源泉徴収票) is not acceptable.
 - B) A copy of the counterfoil of final tax return with the seal of reception of the Tax Office (e-Tax: submit Receipt Notification and Final Tax Return)
 - C) A certificate of bank deposit balance
- Certificate of Residence “Jyuminhyo”(with all the matters listed except for individual number (“My Number”) and Resident record code)
- Copy of Passport
- Copy of the valid residence card (Both front & back)

Note

- Embassy may issue a single entry visa after the assessment of the application.
- The above is a guide to the documents you should provide with your visa application. Japan Embassy may request you for an interview / additional documentation depending on your personal circumstances.
- Documents submitted will not be returned (except for the passport).
