6	Marriage Certificate  (Issued by PSA within 1 year and for Married Applicants only)	* If Marriage Certificate is not readable, submit Marriage certificate issued by Local Civil Registrar.  *If there is no record of marriage in PSA, submit Marriage Certificate issued by Local Civil Registrar and Negative Certificate issued by PSA.

10	Itinerary in Japan	Please provide the itinerary details.		
11	Residence Certificate (Jumin-hyo) of Inviter and Guarantor	* Jumin-hyo must describe all household members, without omission of description except Individual Number and Jumin-hyo Code.  * If inviter or his/her spouse is Japanese, submit his/her Family register or (Koseki-tohon).
