Checklist

1	Visa application form duly completed in Latin characters using the Electronic Visa Application Form https://www.migracija.lt/ , printed and signed by the applicant.	
2	Passport (original and copy of ID page): - valid at least three (3) months after the intended date of departure from the Schengen territory; - containing at least two (2) blank pages; - issued within the previous ten (10) years.	
3	One colour photograph 35×45 mm with light colour background, no older than six (6) months.	
Supporting documents		
4	Proof that your family member is EU/EEA/Swiss national: - copy of family member's passport; - proof of relations (for example, birth, marriage or registered partnership certificate legalised or issued with an apostille).	
5	Proof of travelling to Lithuania with your family member or joining them in Lithuania If joining your family member: - flight reservation in your name; - proof that your family member is using or has recently used his/her right to free movement (for example, a certificate confirming their right of residence in Lithuania). If travelling together, flight reservation in your family member's name.	
6	If the applicant is a minor: - birth certificate or other legal document showing the relationship between the applicant and parents or legal guardians (original and copy); - parent(s) or legal guardian's passport (original and copy). If travelling with one parent: written consent certified by public notary of the other parent or legal guardian, except in cases of a parent having sole custody or guardianship of the minor (original and copy). If travels alone (without parents): written consent, certified by a public notary, of both parents or legal guardians (original and copy).
