

	<b>LUXEMBOURG</b> <b>Application for a Schengen visa for the purpose of a tourist visit</b> <b>REQUIRED DOCUMENTS</b>	<b>EVET</b>	<b>HAYIR</b>
1	<b>A completed and signed Schengen visa application form.</b>		
2	<b>One passport-size photograph according to ICAO standards and not older than 3 months. If the photo is not up to standard it will be rejected.</b>		
3	<b>Passport or other travel document:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Copy of the personal details page of the passport/travel document and of the pages having entry/exit stamps on them.</li> <li>• Copy of previously issued Schengen visas</li> </ul> <b>Please note:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Your passport or travel document must be valid for at least 3 months from the date on which you leave the Schengen area.</li> <li>-It must have at least 2 empty visa pages</li> <li>-It cannot have been issued more than 10 years ago.</li> </ul>		
4	<b>Evidence of legal residence in the country you are applying from, e.g. a passport, visa or residence permit,</b>		
5	<b><u>Travel itinerary (travel reservations in your name, not a ticket).</u></b> <b><u>Note: make travel reservations which you can cancel</u></b>		
6	<b><u>Documents proving your visit is for tourist purposes.</u></b> For example: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hotel reservation(s) for the duration of your visit.</li> <li>• 3 recent bank statements.</li> <li>• If you are employed: a declaration from your employer stating the period of your absence</li> </ul>		
7	<b><u>Proof of financial means</u></b> Pay slip/pay stub covering 3 month's salary or, if unemployed, 3 recent monthly bank statements		
8	<b><u>Proof of health insurance, i.e. an official document from your insurer proving that:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The insurance policy has been taken out in your name</li> <li>• Your insurance is valid throughout the Schengen area and for the duration of your visit</li> <li>• At least 30.000 EUR of medical costs are reimbursed</li> <li>• Medical costs, including hospital care, emergency treatment and repatriation (including in the event of death) are covered</li> </ul> <b>Please note:</b> If your insurer will not provide an official document of this nature, you should take out travel insurance with appropriate medical cover for this trip with one that does.		
9	<b><u>Documents proving that you will return to your own country after your trip</u></b> For example: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A declaration from your employer, an employment contract or other information proving you are employed in your country of origin</li> <li>• A document proving you are in education or training in your country of origin</li> <li>• A document proving your children attend school in your country of origin</li> <li>• A document proving you have a home or other immovable property in your country of origin</li> </ul>		
10	<b>If you are applying for a Schengen visa for a minor who will be travelling alone or with 1 parent, please submit the following documents:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A copy of the minor's birth certificate</li> <li>• A copy of an identity document bearing the parents' signature (1 document for each parent).</li> <li>• A declaration of consent from both parents, stating that the minor can travel.</li> <li>• If relevant: a court judgement stating which parent has been allocated parental responsibility for the minor.</li> <li>• If relevant: a declaration from the minor's school consenting to their absence.</li> </ul>
