3	Two identical passport photographs, up-to-date and in good condition, allowing proper identification		
4	Copy of Previous Passport, if applicable		
5	Valid travel insurance covering necessary medical expenses, including emergency assistance and repatriation.		
6	Form authorizing Serviço de Estrangeiros e Fronteiras - SEF (Portuguese Immigration and Border Service) to consult your criminal record: https://vistos.mne.gov.pt/images/schengen/formularios/aut_consulta_rc.pdf		
7	Police Clearance Certificate (PCC) from the applicant's country of origin or country of residency for over one year. The PCC is only considered valid up to three months after the date of issuance. Older PCC's will not be accepted. Minors under 16 years of age are exempt from producing any criminal record related document. The PCC should be issued by a Regional Passport Office (RPO) and attested with Apostille from RPO or from MEA.		
8	Evidence of means of subsistence.		
9	Notification of Family Reunification approval issued by SEF (Serviço de Estrangeiros e Fronteiras – SEF).		
10	<p>Proof of the family affiliation invoked: birth certificate/marriage certificate – Originals to be submitted, duly attested, at VFS, which will take a copy locally and forward it to the Embassy, so that applicants may retain the original certificates.</p> <p>NB: Indian documents need to be attested first by competent State / Union Territory Department where the document was issued; and then by the Ministry of External Affairs of India with the apostille sticker. 11	Minors or unfit persons require a travel authorization by the parents (both parents are required to sign the letter authorizing the minor to travel) or legal guardian.		

Note: (1) Applicant could be asked for additional documents or may be called for an Interview if desired by The Embassy of Portugal, New Delhi. (2) The visa fee, according to Schengen regulations, is non-refundable. (3) Carry All documents in Original at the time of interview. (4) National Visas require a consultation of one or more authorities in Portugal, therefore the Embassy and those authorities require at least 30 working days after the visa is submitted or after interview (if the same is requested by the Embassy) to process the visa application.
