<ul> <li>The Schengen states does not accept Indian handwritten passports or passports that contains a manual entry made after 01/04/2010 where the biographical data (name, place, date of birth and sex) were changed.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Previous passport/s:</li> <li>If any irrespective of its condition, bound together with rubber band, not stapled (in case lost a note is required).</li> </ul>	
Clear photocopies of all previous Schengen Visa, if stamped on another passport together with photocopies of the 1 <sup>st</sup> page (bio data) and last page of the passport.

The "Statement of Responsibility" <b>must be original, duly certified by a Portuguese Public Notary or lawyer.</b> * If the applicant is a national of Bhutan, Nepal and the Maldives, the documents attested previously by the correspondent Ministry of Foreign

- Visa applications should be submitted in advance to ensure time for competent authorities to deliver a decision.
- A booked flight ticket does not result in a preferred processing of the application.
- All documents, forms and declarations must be submitted either in Portuguese or English. All
  documents, forms and declarations not in Portuguese or English have to be submitted with
  proper Portuguese or English translation. Failing to provide proper translation will result in
  the document, form or declaration considered "missing".
- The refusal of the visa application does not entail the reimbursement of the visa fees.
