	Police Clearance Certificate (PCC) from the applicant's country of origin or country of residency for over one year. The PCC is only considered valid up to three months after the date of issuance. Older PCC's will not be accepted. The PCC should be issued by a Regional Passport Office (RPO) and attested with Apostille from RPO or from MEA.		
	Proof of accommodation.		
	Invitation letter from a recognized University or Professional Training Institute with the details of the position being offered. Or Term of Responsibility issued by a company certified under the terms defined by the ordinance of the Members of the Government responsible for the areas of Internal Administration and Economy. Or An invitation letter from the company/organization that currently is developing in Portugal a cultural activity recognized by the Ministry of Culture as being of great significance to Portugal Or An invitation letter from a recognized research centre.

	Valid work contract or work promise, for a minimum period of one year and for a salary of 1,5 times de annual gross salary, or three times the indexed value for social welfare support (IAS).		

	The Original contract should be attested by a lawyer in Portugal. The work contract should start after the date of arrival in Portugal.		
	Proof of relevant (1) academic qualifications, duly attested , and (2) professional experience in the work contract's related field 1. Indian Diplomas/Degrees need to be attested first by competent State / Union Territory Department where the document was issued; and then by the Ministry of External Affairs of India with the apostille sticker. Employers declaration + Salary Slips / receipts for the last three months + bank statement for the last six months + ITR (model V for Indian citizens) for the last 3 years.		

Note: (1) All above documents are mandatory to submit. Applicant could be asked for additional documents or may be called for an Interview if desired by The Consulate of Portugal, Goa. (2) The visa fee, according to Schengen regulations, is non-refundable. (3) Carry All documents in Original at the time of interview. (4) National Visas require a consultation of one or more authorities in Portugal, therefore the Consulate and those authorities require at least 30 working days after the visa is submitted or after interview (if the same is requested by the Consulate) to process the visa application.
