Passport or other travel document, valid for at least 3 months after the estimated date of the stay. Photocopy of passport (biographical data).			
Proof of regular situation, if you are of a nationality other than that of the country where you are applying for a visa, valid for more than the date of expiry of the visa you are applying for.			
Valid travel insurance, covering necessary medical expenses, including urgent medical assistance and possible repatriation.			
Criminal record certificate , issued by the competent authority of the country of the applicant's nationality or of the country where the applicant has resided for over a year (except for applicants under sixteen), with the Hague Apostille (If applicable) or legalised.			
Applicants from Nepal, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Bhutan and the Maldives must have their documents attested previously by the correspondent Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the respective embassy in New Delhi, as well as by the Embassy of Portugal in New Delhi (<i>document must be</i> <i>legalised already at the moment of handing their application</i>).			
Request for criminal record enquiry by the Immigration and Border Services (SEF) (<i>Not applicable to minors under the age of sixteen</i>).			
Transport document - Roundtrip flight reservation showing date of departure and date of return.			
Proof of financial resources equivalent to at least the sum of three guaranteed monthly minimum salary.

 a) Presentation of a term of responsibility, signed by a Portuguese citizen or a foreign citizen, with a residence permit in Portugal, which guarantees food and accommodation for the visa applicant, as well as the replacement of removal costs, in case of irregular stay. The citizen that subscribes the Statement of Responsibility must have the financial capacity equal to three times the value of the monthly minimum remuneration. 	
SPECIFIC DOCUMENTS	
Declaration with indication of the conditions for the estimated stay. <u>This declaration is a letter of intent, in which the applicant must identify,</u> <u>explain his motivations for applying for a visa and which area/field</u> <u>he/she has experience and the one in which he/she intends to work. It</u> <u>will also be relevant to indicate the place of residence or where the</u> <u>applicant will stay while in Portugal (complete address), even if</u> <u>temporarily, as well as telephone and email contact.</u>	
Proof of presentation of a declaration of expression of interest for enrolment in the IEFP, submitted online.	

Note:

- The Consular Post has the prerogative to request additional documents when it considers fit to do so.
- The presentation of all necessary documents in the visa application may not be construed as an automatic approval of the visa. The refusal of the visa request does not entail the reimbursement of the visa fees.

- Failure to present all necessary documents may result in the visa application being refused.
