<p>CPLP citizens are exempted from presenting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> travel insurance, means of subsistence, and, return transport ticket. <p>upon presentation of a statement of responsibility in the following terms:</p> <p>a) Presentation of a term with a recognized signature issued by the host entity for interns or workers, as well as by the organization responsible for student exchange or volunteer programs; or,</p> <p>b) Presentation of a term of responsibility, with a recognized signature, signed by a Portuguese citizen or a foreign citizen, with a residence permit in Portugal, which guarantees food and accommodation for the visa applicant, as well as the replacement of removal costs, in case of irregular stay.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
