Notes: Failure to submit all the necessary documents may lead to the rejection of the visa application. The Consular Post reserves the right to request supplementary documents if necessary. Even if all the requested documents are presented, it does not imply the automatic granting of the visa. The visa fee is not refunded if the visa is refused.
