<p><b>CPLP citizens are exempted from presenting:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• travel insurance,</li> <li>• means of subsistence, and</li> <li>• return transport ticket</li> </ul> <p><b>upon presentation of responsibility term in the following terms:</b></p> <p>a) Presentation of a term signed by the host entity for interns or workers, as well as by the organization responsible for student exchange or volunteer programs.</p> <p>b) Presentation of a term of responsibility, signed by a Portuguese citizen or a foreign citizen, with a residence permit in Portugal, which guarantees food and accommodation for the visa applicant, as well as the replacement of removal costs, in case of irregular stay.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
