#### NATIONAL VISAS – LONG TERM VISAS

### **Types**

**Temporary stay visa** - is intended to allow entry into Portugal for a period of less than 1 year. It will be valid for the duration of the stay and for multiple entries in Portugal.

*Visa to obtain a residence permit -* valid for two entries and for four months, during which period the holder must apply to the Aliens and Borders Service for a residence permit.
