

PORTUGAL CHECKLIST

NATIONAL VISAS – LONG TERM VISAS

Types

Temporary stay visa - is intended to allow entry into Portugal for a period of less than 1 year. It will be valid for the duration of the stay and for multiple entries in Portugal.

Visa to obtain a residence permit - valid for two entries and for four months, during which period the holder must apply to the Aliens and Borders Service for a residence permit.
