 CPLP citizens are exempted from presenting: travel insurance, means of subsistence, and, return transport ticket. upon presentation of a statement of responsibility in the following terms: a) Presentation of a term with a recognized signature issued by the host entity for interns or workers, as well as by the organization responsible for student exchange or volunteer programs; or, b) Presentation of a term of responsibility, with a recognized signature, signed by a Portuguese citizen or a foreign citizen, with a residence permit in Portugal, which guarantees food and accommodation for the visa applicant, as well as the replacement of removal costs, in case of irregular stay. 			
Simplified procedure: The third-state national who has been admitted for the purpose of seasonal work in national territory (NT), at least once in the last five years, and who has complied with the provisions of the law regarding entry and stay in Portugal, benefits from a simplified procedure when granting a new temporary stay visa for seasonal work,
