Simplified procedure for the second request: The third-country national who has been admitted for the purpose of seasonal work in national territory, at least once within the last five years, and who has complied with the provisions of the law regarding entry and stay in Portugal, benefit from a simplified procedure when granting a new temporary stay visa for seasonal work. Namely, it <b>is exempt</b> from presenting the documents referred to in article 51°A(1)(c) to (e)of Law n° 23/2007 of 4 of June (accommodation, proof of regulated profession and return transport ticket) and the request must be treated as a priority and the decision period shall not exceed 15 days.
